Step 1

- Before using the hose/jet washer check that all connections are tight.
- Ensure that pipes are not left trailing across public access areas, eg pavements when using the hose/jet washer.
- Turn off all electrical equipment in the vicinity.
- Visually inspect the jet washer, power cable and plug. If any signs of damage, exposed wires or scorch marks are evident, do not use the equipment. Refer to SOP OF0040 - Electrical safety (general).
- The jet washer must be plugged into an electrical socket which is RCD protected.
- Ensure that the water supply to the jet washer is turned on prior to switching the jet washer on.

Step 2

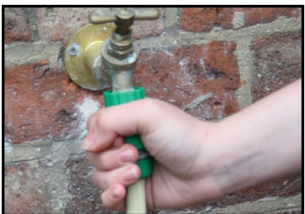
- When using the jet washer or hose pipe in the cellar:
- Do not spray water directly onto any electrical equipment such as coolers, line cleaning machine and plug sockets.
 - Do not spray water onto the Cellarguard carbon dioxide sensor.
 - Ensure that all casks have hard spiles, or equivalent, in place.

Step 3



- Ensure that pooling water is brushed into the floor drain.
- After jet washing floors and drains in the cellar, ensure that walls, fixture and fittings are wiped down using a blue cloth.

Step 4



- External areas must be washed down as required using a hose or jet washer.
- This must be completed out of hours, ideally before the pub opens.
- If spot cleaning, then the lance attachment must be used.
- If cleaning large flat areas, then the patio cleaner head attachment must be used.
- Do not use the jet washer on windows or any other fragile/breakable materials.
- Use the external taps to connect hoses/jet washers to, and ensure they are turned off after use.
- Wipe down window facias and garden furniture after using the hose/jet washer.

Step 5



- After use, ensure the hose pipe is coiled and stored away from walkways or public thoroughfares.
- Store the jet washer in a secure location.
- Display a hazard warning sign ('Wet floor' or 'Cleaning in progress') until the area is fully dry.

Step 6



- Report any maintenance issues via the property maintenance system.
- Replacement jet washers, attachments and RCD circuit breakers can be ordered via the property maintenance system, supply only order.
- Replacement RCD circuit breakers can be ordered via the non-consumables order.
- Jet washing machines must be PAT tested annually.
- Do not use machines with exposed or damaged wiring.
- Do not use jet washers or hoses in freezing conditions.
